

Command Line Parameters

MaxLoad Pro supports the following command line options:

Command	Description
-DBPath=<path>	Allows users to override the .ini file and specify a different location for the software to find its data. Use the Maxload.mdb in the specified path instead of checking in the path indicated in the Maxload2.ini file.
-Import=<path>	This command automatically imports the specified file when the software starts. For example, an order processing system could first export an order file and then when Maxload Pro is launched, the data would automatically be imported. Imports the specified file on startup if it exists.
-Ini=<path>	Allows users to specify the location of the specific topspro.ini file that they want to use. Use the specified INI file instead of the one in C:\Windows\maxload2.ini file.
-MultiDb=On	With this option, users can specify multiple database paths (dbpath) in the Maxload2.ini file. With this feature activated, the user will be prompted on startup, for which database to use.
-User=<username>	Automatically logs the user into the software as a specified user. This allows the user to skip the login screen.
-View	Starts the program in view only mode. View only mode prevents the user from being able to modify any data in the program.

Note: User names, paths, and filenames that contain spaces or other delimiters should be enclosed in double quotation marks like “this”.
